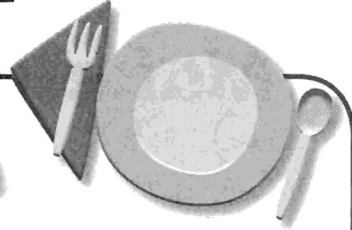


A letter to our Preschool families for MARCH

Ideas for Busy Families

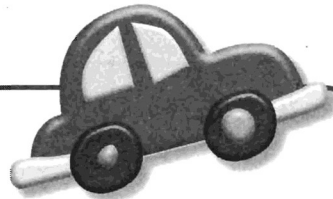
In the Kitchen



In this unit, your child is learning about farm animals.

- Discuss how people on a farm work hard to feed, protect, and take care of their animals. This conversation will help your child to better understand the unit theme of *Animals Around Us*.
- Give your child animal crackers. Have him or her put ten animal crackers in a row and count them. Then have your child separate the animal crackers into groups, by animals. This will help your child to practice counting and sorting.

On the Move



In this unit, your child is learning about taking care of animals.

- Discuss the responsibilities of being a pet owner with your child. Talk about the need to provide water, meals, warmth, and safety for a pet.
- Take your child to a public area where he or she will see people with pets. Talk about how these owners might take care of their pets. Talk about how baby animals grow into adult animals.
