Ideas for Busy Families

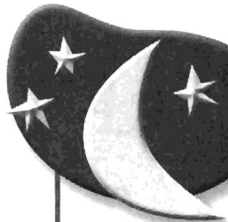
On the Move



In this unit, your child is learning about different animals that live on land.

- As you move about your town, talk with your child about wild animals that you see. Talk about their basic needs, such as water, food, and air.
- Take your child to a library to review books with photographs of wild animals. Have your child describe some of them.

At Bath and Bed Time



In this unit, your child is learning about animals that live in and near the water.

- While your child is taking a bath, talk about animals that live in and near the water. Explain that some swim and float. Discuss animals such as ducks, frogs, and turtles.
- You may wish to demonstrate how some animals float. Let your child place a sponge in a sink or bathtub full of water. Talk about how the sponge floats.
