Health Inventory Compliance

The Office of Child Care Health Inventory is a health and safety form that is required for a child's enrollment in a licensed child care program. Some components of the Health Inventory are completed by the parent and other components are completed by the child's physician at the child's health care appointment.

Please note the time frame requirements for submission of this form, as stated in the Maryland Department of Education—Office of Child Care Regulation listed below:

COMAR 13A.16.03 Management and Administration—"The date of the appointment required by SF(2) of this regulation may not be later than 20 calendar days after the date the child was temporarily admitted or retained.
