



Electronics Agreement

Screen Time Activities during Play Centers' program hours will follow COMAR regulations. Interactive Technology is educational and age appropriate technology, including programs, applications, noncommercial television programming, videos, etc. that are designed to facilitate active and creative technology and encourage social engagement with other children and adults. Interactive Technology is approved by MSDE to be used for the duration of the school day while Virtual Learning (if applicable). Passive Technology is to be kept to a maximum of 30 minutes in order to allow opportunities for other types of play indoors and outdoors, as well as to align with current practices regarding minimizing screen time for children. However, there may be special times and circumstances when the use of electronics would be permitted. In anticipation of this event, the following agreement must be completed and on file in order for individual use of personal electronics in the Play Centers' program. The staff will be actively involved and utilize all screen experiences as a way to enhance learning for each child.

It is understood and agreed that:

1. The Play Centers' participant is solely responsible for his/her electronic device.
2. He/She will ensure that his/her name is on the electronic device.
3. Sharing of electronic devices will not be permitted.
4. All video games must be rated "E" for "Everyone".
5. Any music played on any device containing inappropriate content or language will not be permitted.
6. Play Centers will not be held responsible for any liability associated with inappropriate use, loss, damage, theft, etc. of personal electronic devices.
7. He/She is not permitted to take any photos of other students or teachers.
